We invite you to ask your child about this process and share with your child about the social causes you are passionate about. If you have any questions please ask your classroom teacher or reach out to us!




They are empowered to research, serve, advocate and persuade their peers through presentations and vote on a local nonprofit to receive their grant.

## THE IMPACT

Service-Learning is a pedagogy that engages students in academic learning while strengthening community ties. It has been shown to support social and emotional needs like increasing self-esteem and self-awareness in students. Studies have shown that supporting social-emotional learning through service-learning led to an 11% increase in academic achievement.



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
